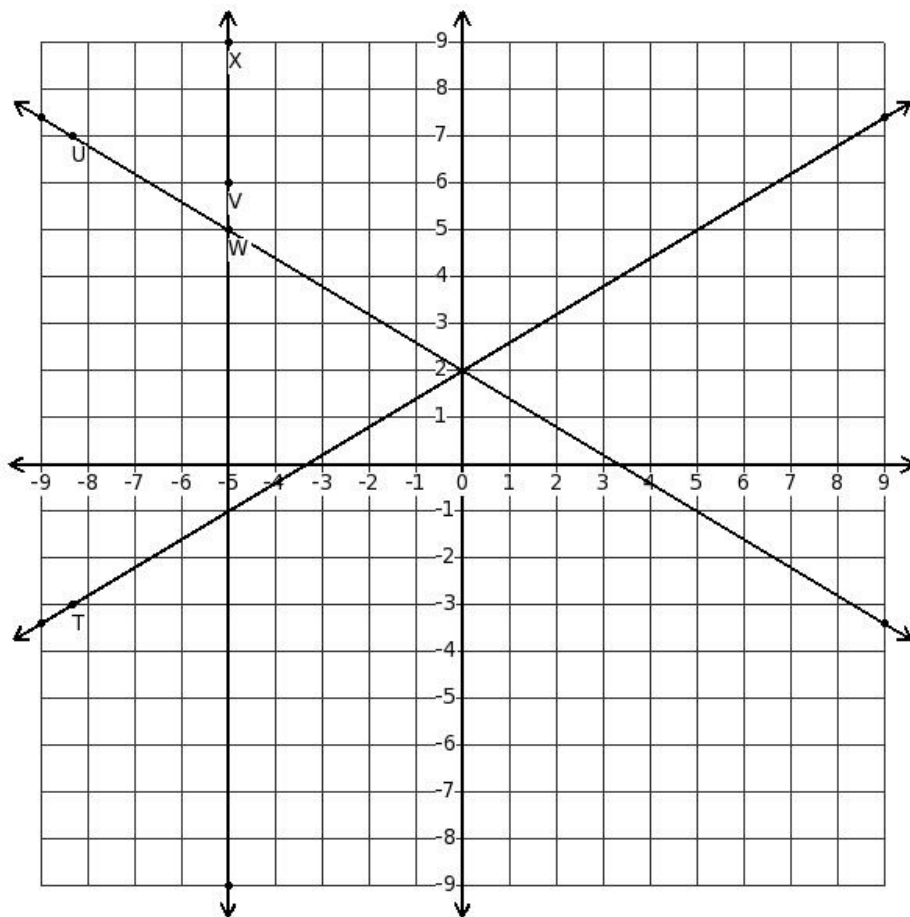

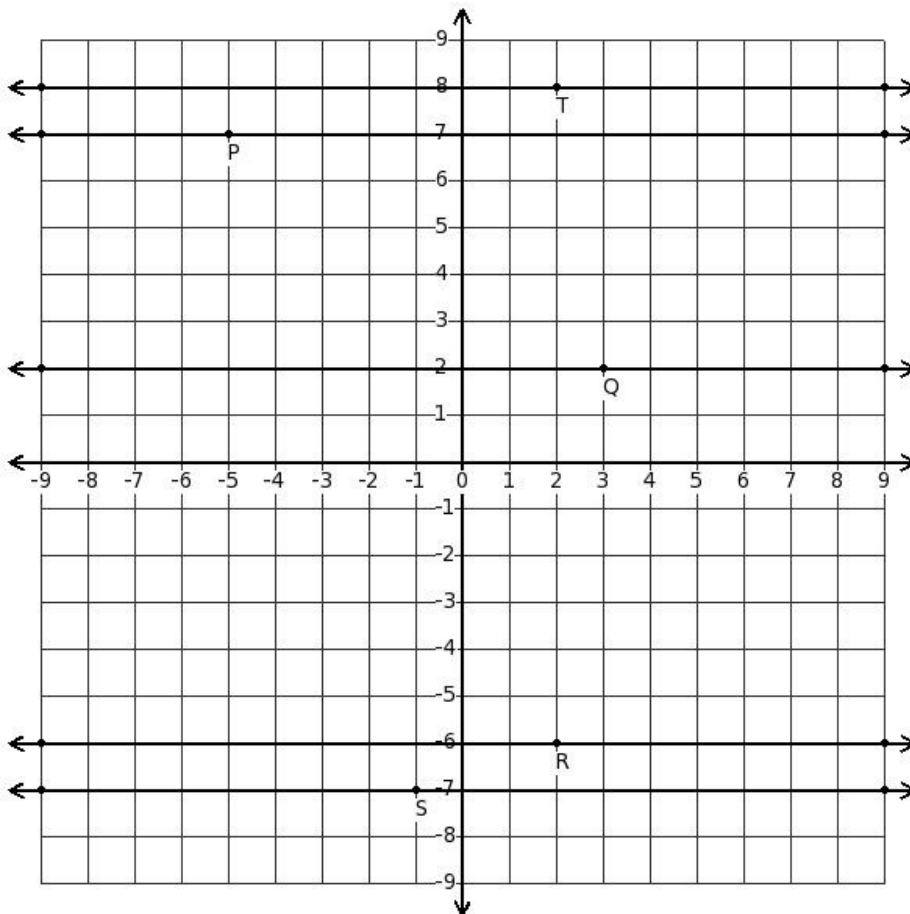

13. Which of the displayed lines represent the equation $(3x - 5y + 10) = 0$?



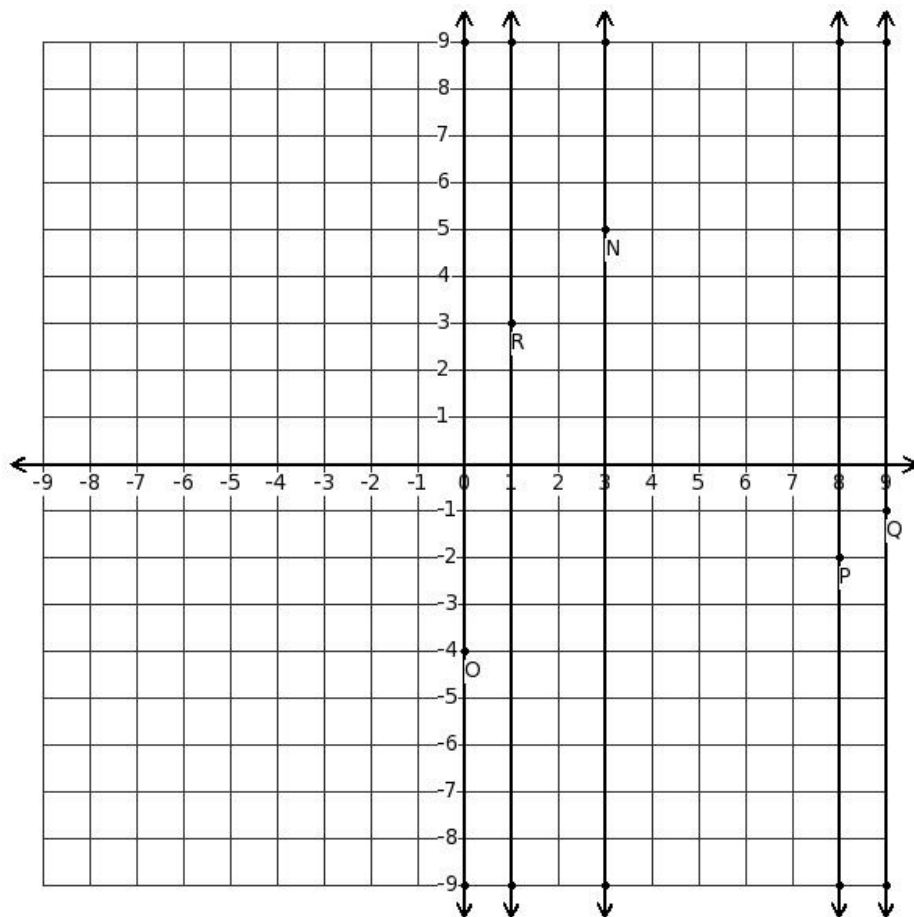

14. Which of the displayed lines represent the equation $y = 7$?



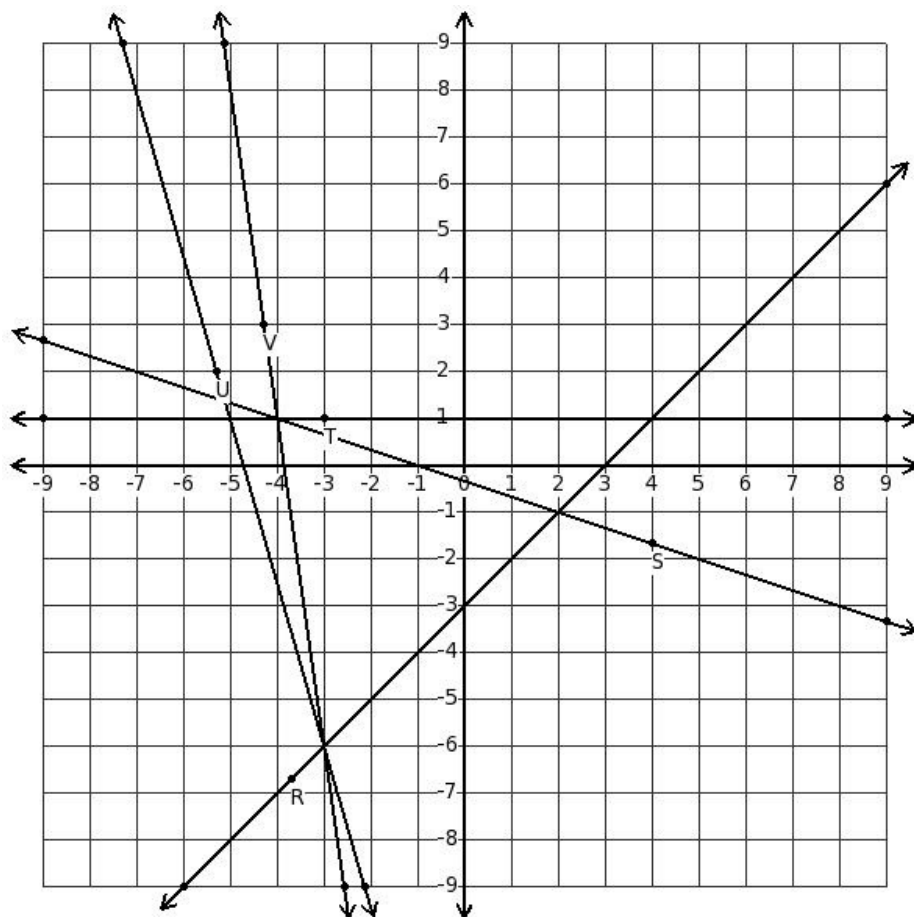

15. Which of the displayed lines represent the equation $x=3$



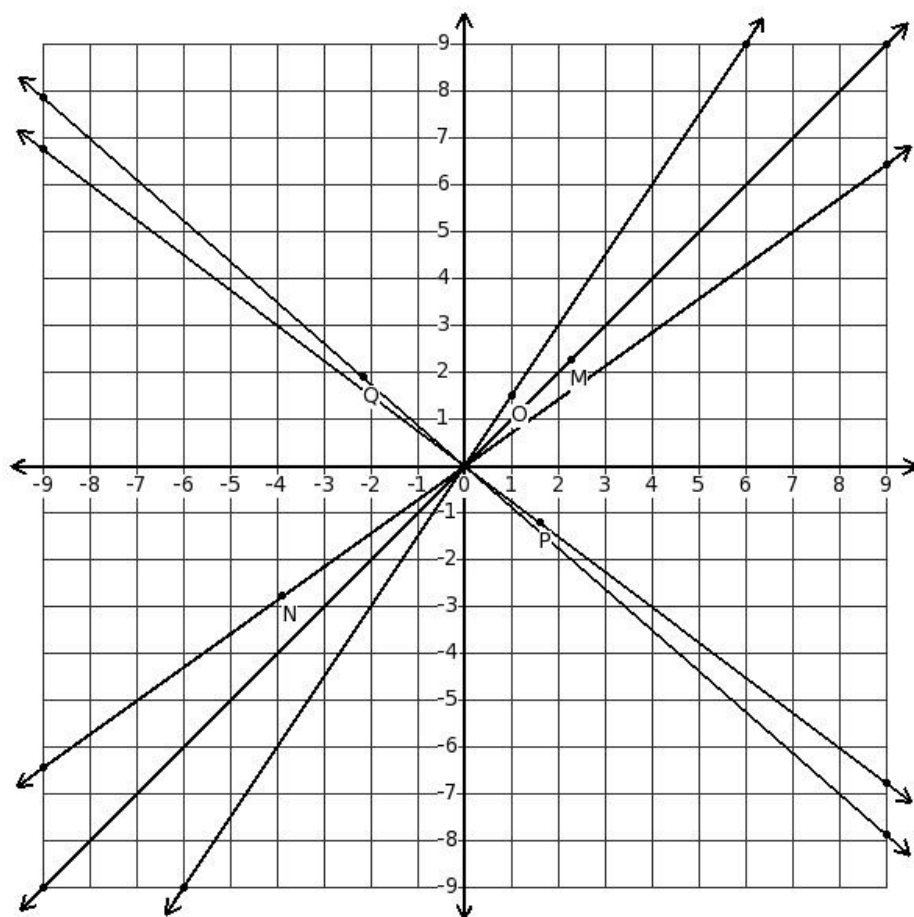
